Dr Amy Cuddy - Harvard Prof of Social Psychology:

45 Subjects - 2 mins powerposing every day - saliva tested before and after to check hormone levels:

- Feel more powerful/successful translates into reality
- 20% rise in Testosterone
- 22%2 drop in Cortisol
