

Hertford Wi-Fi pre-registration

It is recommended that students pre-register for access to the Hertford wireless network ahead of your arrival. Upon completion of your registration, you will be provided with a code which will allow you to connect to the Hertford wireless network.

Before proceeding, you *must* have activated your University of Oxford Single Sign-On (SSO) account.

The below steps should be performed once **per person**, *NOT* once per device – wireless codes can be used on an unlimited number of devices owned by the SSO account holder.

A wireless code is for the exclusive use of the SSO account holder who created it; *you must not share your code.*

1. From any device on any network, visit <u>https://wifi.hertford.ox.ac.uk</u> or scan the QR code:



2. Agree to the terms and conditions by ticking the check box, then press Start.

3. Choose the Wireless option.

4. When prompted, sign in using your SSO credentials.

5. You will be issued a code for wireless network access – this will appear on screen and be e-mailed to you.

6. When you arrive at a Hertford site, connect to the wireless network named **Hertford** using the code you were issued.

Codes generated in this manner are valid for **one year** of access; you will need to follow this process again in a year's time.
