

Notes for the Alain Locke Studentship 2026-27

Studentship period

- The Alain Locke Studentship is tenable for one academic year, from Michaelmas Term 2026 to Trinity Term 2027.

Value and Payment

- The studentship comprises £5,000 (split into two payments of £1666.67 and one payment of £1666.66 made at the start of each term).
- If you complete your studies before the end of the studentship period, you will not receive any further termly payments.
- If you have received payment for the term in which you complete your studies, you are not required to make any repayments.
- If, during the studentship period, you intend to suspend your studies, you should get in touch with the [Academic Office](#) to discuss how this may affect the payment schedule of the studentship.

Accommodation

- The holder of the Alain Locke Studentship is entitled to free Hertford College accommodation for the duration of the studentship; please contact the [Accommodation Officer](#) to make arrangements.
- Accommodation will be single accommodation.
- No cash alternative will be available.

Migration

- When you take up the studentship, you are required to migrate to Hertford. This involves the Hertford Academic Office liaising with your current college and the Academic Records Office to request relevant paperwork from your student file, and to make changes to your student record.
- Please note that your email address will change to your.name@hertford.ox.ac.uk but as your SSO stays the same no content should be lost.
- You will also receive a new Bod card that you will need to collect from the Hertford Academic Office (OB1.8) at the start of term.
